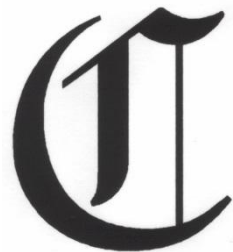


Extra-Curricular Activities

Cost for the term: £180, plus £96 for equipment hire, if required - will be added to the end-of-term bill. Maximum number: 16
